Our mission is to provide therapeutic programs to children who experience domestic violence.

ABOUT US

Randi's House of Angels was established by Nancy J. Chavez as a tribute to her daughter, Randi Trimble, who was brutally murdered on January 10, 2003, by a hit man hired by her own husband.

Since her daughter's death, Nancy has been an advocate for victims of domestic violence with a focus on creating initiatives for children who are also victims. In 2011, Nancy created Randi's House of Angels, a project of The Foundation for Enhancing Communities, fiscal agent, to fulfill her dream of helping children and families who are exposed to and are victims of domestic violence.

Programs offered through RHOA include trauma-informed therapy, both individual and group therapies, designed to help children. RHOA works with domestic violence and crime victim agencies, community agencies, schools, churches and other therapeutic organizations to provide these therapy programs.

All programs are offered at no cost to the parents/guardians and agencies. Transportation can be provided for families in need.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A child must be a victim of domestic violence or have been exposed to domestic violence in their homes.
- A child must be at least 8 years old and no older than 13 years old to attend Randi's Kidz Club and Randi's Camp for Hope and Courage
- A child must be at least 5 years old and no older than 7 years old to attend Randi's Klubhouse
- Parents and guardians must commit to bringing children to all sessions.

RANDI'S KIDZ CLUB

- An evidence-based therapeutic group for children who have experienced domestic violence.
- Ten-week interactive group curriculum is designed for children ages 8-13 years who have experienced or have been exposed to domestic violence.
- Ongoing interactive group focused on helping children express feelings and emotions through games, art therapy, and relaxation techniques.
- Facilitated by Master level clinicians with specialized training in trauma informed care, who are certified as Mandated and Permissive Reporters, and have the PA Child Abuse Clearance and Criminal background checks required by the Child Protective Law.
- Randi's Kidz Club sessions offered at no cost to parents/guardians.

RANDI'S CAMP FOR HOPE AND COURAGE

- A three-day outcome-based therapeutic and recreational camp for children ages 8-13 years who have experienced/been exposed to domestic violence.
- Facilitated by Master level clinicians with specialized training in trauma informed care, who are certified as Mandated and Permissive Reporters, and have the PA Child Abuse Clearance and Criminal background checks required by the Child Protective Law.
- Children participate in structured therapeutic activities, allowing them to explore their emotions and develop new coping and communication skills.
- Children meet new friends and have fun during the recreational portion of the camp day.
- Randi's Camp is offered at no cost to the parents/guardians.

RANDI'S KLUBHOUSE

- A ten-week, evidence-based interactive therapeutic group for children, ages 5-7 years, who have experienced domestic violence.
- This new program blends emotional and art therapy, and psychoeducation to children using kind, gentle and playful interactions, and wellness options such as yoga, meditation, etc. The program also involves non-violent parents or caretakers.
- Requirement of both the parent and child for participation in therapy group.
- Facilitated by Master level clinicians with specialized training in trauma informed care, who are certified as Mandated and Permissive Reporters, and have the PA Child Abuse Clearance and Criminal background checks required by the Child Protective Law.
- Randi's Klubhouse sessions offered at no cost to parents/guardians.

RANDI'S TEEN CLUB

- A psycho-educational support group focused on compassion, encouragement, and positive praise for teens, ages 13-17 years who have experienced domestic violence.
- Provides educational, interpersonal, and fun activities for teens to help increase their self-esteem, self-concept, and confidence in their own abilities.
- Ongoing interactive group that empowers teens to believe that their thoughts, feelings, and actions are important and worthy of expression.
- Facilitated by Master level clinicians with specialized training in trauma informed care and meets state mandated child abuse requirements and clearances under the PA Child Protective Services Law.
- Randi's Teen Group offered at no cost to parents/guardian.
